

**BY-LAW NO. 224/60**

Being a By-law of the Village of Bentley to regulate the use of mobile homes within the Village of Bentley.

WHEREAS certain areas have been set aside and designated by the Village of Bentley for use as trailer parks, and these trailer parks are serviced by water, sewer and electric power in such a manner as to be available for use by mobile homes.

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted that mobile homes must not be occupied while situated on any property within the Village of Bentley except when situated within the aforesaid trailer parks.

NOT WITHSTANDING the preceding paragraph, holiday trailers, used by tourists on vacation, may be occupied on private property within the Village of Bentley for a period of not more than thirty (30) days. After the thirty (30) day period, such holiday trailers will be classed as mobile homes and required to move to a trailer park.

READ a first, a second and a third time and finally passed this 26 day of October 1960.
