## **POLICY NO. 16/00**

POLICY TITLE: TRAFFIC SIGN INSPECTION

DATE ADOPTED: November 7, 2000

**PURPOSE:** 

The Council of the Town of Bentley, while fully recognizing the Town has financial limitations and other limitations, intends to define its liability and role with respect to the inspection, maintenance, and repair of its traffic signs.

**POLICY:** 

- 1. On an annual basis, the Town will make a reasonable effort to assess the general condition in which its traffic signs are in.
- 2. On an annual basis, with due regard to its fiscal and other limitations, the Town will make reasonable effort to repair or replace as much of those traffic signs identified to be replaced due to fading, or other conditions that would hinder or obscure the visibility of the sign.
- 3. The Town shall, within 24 hours of receiving a complaint of a faded or missing or obscured sign, investigate and take whatever actions as may be deemed reasonably necessary so as to restore the effectiveness of a traffic sign.
- 4. The provisions of the Municipal Government Act, and amendments thereto, shall prevail over this Policy and the Town, through adherence with this Policy and the Municipal Government Act may neither admit to, nor be held liable for, any direct or indirect damages as a result of traffic signs being unlawfully removed, bent, obscured or otherwise rendered ineffective.
