which results in damage or injury or which could have resulted in

damage or injury.

The term "equipment" refers to all gas, diesel, propane, natural gas or

electric propelled equipment or vehicles owned or leased by the Town.

**Policy** 

Staff involved in a collision or near collision or other accident shall Statement:

report immediately to the Public Works Foreman.

An incident report shall be completed and filed for all collisions

following Standard Operating Guidelines. The Public Works Foreman shall review and discuss the incident with the employee. A written incident report shall be completed and filed for all collisions, following

Standard Operating Guidelines.

All policies shall be adhered to by the Public Works Department, subject to the financial

and manpower resources of the Town.
