

By-law No. 195/2017

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF BENTLEY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, RESPECTING THE DEFINITION OF "PEACE OFFICER" AND THE AMENDMENT OF SEVERAL TOWN OF BENTLEY BY-LAWS TO INCLUDE THE DEFINITION OF "PEACE OFFICER".

WHEREAS, pursuant to:

Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, M-26, and amendments thereto, a Council may pass by-laws respecting the enforcement of by-laws.

Section 1 (k)(vii) of Provincial Offences Procedure Act, RSA 2006, P-34 and amendments thereto, a person who is employed or retained by a municipality for the preservation and maintenance of the public peace in the exercise or discharge of their powers and duties will be considered a "peace Officer" for the purposes of that Act.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Bentley, duly assembled enacts;

- 1. "Peace Officer" means:
 - (i) A police officer
 - (ii) A person appointed as a peace officer pursuant to the Peace Officer Act, SA 2006, P-3.5 or
 - (III) A person appointed as a bylaw enforcement officer pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, M-26 and amendments thereto
- 2. That Town of Bentley By-laws, being:

By-law No. 128/2008 Fire Protection Emergency Response By-law

shall be amended to include the definition of "Peace Officer" as defined in this by-law.

3. This By-law No. 195/2017 shall come into force and effect upon final reading thereof
