BY-LAW NO. 83/44

A By-law of the Village of Bentley, Province of Alberta to provide for a penalty to apply to By-laws of the Village of Bentley, in which no penalty is included.

The Municipal Council of the Village of Bentley enacts as follows:

Each and every By-law of the Village of Bentley, in which no penalty clause is included, shall be deemed to have and shall be read as if the following clause were a part of each such said By-law:

"Any person found guilty of an infraction of this By-law shall be liable upon summary conviction, to a fine of not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) and not more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00), together with the costs of the conviction. Any person failing to pay the amount of such fine and costs shall be liable to imprisonment in the Provincial Jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days."

READ a first time this 3 day of July 1944.

READ a second time this 3 day of July 1944.

READ a third time and finally passed this 3 day of July 1944.
