By submitting this application, I agree for my personal information to be reviewed for eligibility to the Vulnerable Person Registry (VPR). If my application is approved, I will be contacted by a VPR Coordinator to confirm the approval via email or letter mail.

I allow the Vulnerable Persons Registry Program of the Town of Bentley to provide the information included in the above application form to first responders for use solely during emergencies. This may include local Fire, Emergency Medical Services (EMS), RCMP and Peace Officers.

I understand that the Vulnerable Persons Registry does not replace 9-1-1 and that I will need to call 9-1-1 if I have a personal emergency. I acknowledge that the VPR does not guarantee my safety but does provide an added safety measure during an emergency or evacuation. First responders will make every effort to increase my safety during an emergency.

If the application is approved, a VPR Coordinator will contact me to confirm my information. It is my responsibility to update my personal information as soon as possible if it changes.

I agree to release the Town of Bentley and its elected officials, employees, and agents from and against all claims, demands, actions, suits, loss, damage, costs, charges and expenses (collectively “Claims”) which I may incur, suffer or be put to because VPR is unable to guarantee my safety or otherwise during an emergency.

I understand that if I am approved, my information will be available to authorized local emergency service groups within 30 days of my application being approved. The VPR will contact me in January of each year review the application. If the VPR is unable to contact me for two weeks I will be removed from the registry.

The Vulnerable Persons Registry is a voluntary program, and I can request to be removed from it at any time. Only the registrant or a legal guardian may authorize the choice to register.

The personal information on this form is collected under the authority of Section 33 (c) of the Alberta Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act. The personal information will be used to process your application, as contact information during an emergency and to document an incident response. The information may be shared with emergency services groups for the purpose of responding to an emergency.
