Policy Title: Storm Sewer Lines, Manholes and Retention Pond Inspection & Maintenance

Date Adopted: February 14, 2012

Review Date: March, 2017

Authority: Municipal Government Act, 2010, p. 34, Section 3 (b) (c) states: "to provide services, facilities or other things that, in the opinion of council, are necessary or desirable for all or a part of the municipality and to develop and maintain safe and viable communities".

Purpose:

- To establish a regular practice of storm sewer retention pond inspection and maintenance
- To establish a regular practice of storm sewer manhole inspection and maintenance
- To ensure uninterrupted storm water diversion to retention pond
- To ensure proper filtering of storm water within the retention pond
- To maintain a core infrastructure asset of the Town
- To follow Provincial Stormwater Management Guidelines

Definitions:

- The term "manhole" refers to lid, collar, rings, barrel, benching, trough and ladder
- The term "pond" refers to the berms, clay liner and drain valve
- The term "valve" refers to the lid, collar(s), pin, sassing and top seat of the valve

Policy Statement: All storm sewer manholes shall be inspected annually following Standard Operating Guidelines

The storm water retention pond's drain valve shall be inspected and exercised annually following Standard Operating Guidelines

This policy shall be adhered to by the Public Works Department and is subject to the financial and manpower resources of the Town.
