The Town of Bentley invites applications from motivated individuals to perform the duties of Seasonal Parks and Recreation Summer Staff for the Town of Bentley. Regular hours and Monday to Friday, 40 hours per week from approximately May 11 to August 28, 2026.

Background:

The Town of Bentley takes pride in maintaining:

2. 3 Ball Diamonds
3. 3km of bike path
4. 4 playgrounds
5. 10-acre sport field facility (under development)
6. 1 acre dog park (under development)
7. 1000 + sq.ft of flower beds
8. Walking paths
9. Numerous hanging baskets and planters
10. All municipally owned green space

Scope of Work:

The successful individuals will be required to perform the following duties:

1. Mowing of all municipally owned parks & playgrounds, ball diamonds, campground, and green spaces
2. Flower bed planting, watering, weeding, and other required maintenance
3. Weed trimming of all municipally owned facilities and green spaces
4. Maintaining treed areas including, pruning and leaf raking.
5. Operation of commercial mowers, push mowers, weed trimmers, water truck and pump, and various small tools and equipment
6. Rotational weekend watering of planters and flower beds (weather permitting)
7. Routine inspections of parks and sport fields
8. Collecting litter
9. Painting
10. Other various Parks and Recreation, and Public Works tasks may be assigned
